eated a last-ditch effort by the US Federal Trade Commission to scuttle the &#12  
7824; company&#39;sR\$68.7 billion purchase of Activision Blizzard. The Ninth Ci  
rcuit Court of Appeals declined to grant the regulator an emergency stay &#12782  
4; of a ruling that allows the deal to proceed in the US. The United Kingdom&#3  
9;s Markets and Competition Authority (CMA) &#127824; is the last remaining reg  
ulator of note opposed to the purchase, but the watchdog and Microsoft recently  
agreed to put &#127824; their legal battle over the deal on hold and negotiate

hough Stephen &#127824; Totilo of Axios later confirmed that it is 10 years in  
duration. Microsoft first offered Sony a 10-year deal to &#127824; keep Call of  
Duty on current and future PlayStation consoles at the end of last year, though  
the Japanese electronics &#127824; giant turned down the olive branch at the t  
ime. In an effort to secure approval from regulators, including the FTC &#127824  
& CMA, Microsoft went on to sign an agreement with Nintendo to bring the se  
ries to the company&#39;s future consoles. &#127824; It also came to terms with
